




Class 2 Spring 1 Information



Welcome back! We hope you have had a lovely Christmas holiday and a much needed rest after the busy Autumn term. We have lots of exciting topics and events to look forward to this term.

Maths

Year 1 and 2 will be learning addition and subtraction up to 100 and Year 3 will be learning how to use written methods of multiplication and division.

Science

Year 3 will be learning about Animals including Humans and year 1 and 2 will be learning all about comparing materials.

PSHE

We will be learning about what it means to belong to a community

Art and/DT

We will be creating sculptures using paper looking at famous sculpture along the way such as Anthony Gormley.

Computing

We will be learning how to move a robot using programming.

English

We will be reading 'Ocean Meets Sky' where we will be learning how to create setting and character descriptions, captain's logs, instructions and how to punctuate dialogue.

Spelling - Helping your child with their weekly spellings by looking at the spelling pattern and practising this will improve their accuracy in their writing. Spelling will be given out on a Friday and tested the following Friday.

Maths -Knowing key facts makes maths lessons easier for the children. Practise on Times Tables Rock Stars and Numbots.
