Welcome back! We hope you have had a lovely Easter holiday and enjoyed the sunshine. We have an action packed term ahead. Please keep your eyes peeled for dates for your children.

What we will be learning about:

Maths: Year 4: Decimals, money, time and shape. Year 5/6: Area, perimeter and volume as well as consolidation of knowledge of decimals and fractions. We will then look at ratio, algebra and shape.

English: We will complete our work on 'The Varmints.' Our next book is 'The Last Bear' which will give us writing opportunities in narrative and newspaper reports.

Science: Year 4: States of Matter and Electricity. Year 5/6: Evolution and Inheritance.

RE: Class 2 will be looking at significant experiences which mark journeys in life and thinking about how different religions deal with difficult experiences in life.

History: Ancient Maya.

Geography: After half term, we will be learning about Climate Change.

Spanish: The weather.

ICT: We will be learning how to take photos and edit them using editing software whilst learning about the ethical side to editing photos for use in the media.

Art: Mayan art and mask design.

DT: During our DT week, Year 4 will be looking at healthy and varied food and diet. Year 5/6 will be investigating structures.

PE: Kwik Cricket, tennis, rounders and athletics. We will also have a professional cricket coach in for five weeks.

PSHE: Physical health and wellbeing.

Music: Preparation for the summer performance!
